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## **33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Outdoor Craft and Marketplace July 5 and 6, 2008**

**APPLICATIONS:** Applications will be accepted on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis. **Application deadline is MAY 15, 2008.** If your application is received prior to May 15<sup>th</sup>, we will try to accommodate all requests for the same space as in 2007. **Your application must include the following:**

- Your application form
- Your \$100 check for EACH 10 X 10 ft. booth.
- Several photos of your merchandise -- even if you have been a participant at Frontier Days, Inc. Marketplace before, you must include photos again. **THIS IS A JURIED SHOW.**
- A stamped, self-addressed envelope so that we can send confirmation information.

**ENTRANCE FEE:** A check **MUST** accompany your application form. Your check will not be deposited until after May 17<sup>th</sup>.

**ACCEPTANCE:** To learn if you have been accepted, check the Frontier Days, Inc. website: [www.frontierdays.org](http://www.frontierdays.org), look under "Marketplace" for your acceptance confirmation and a copy of the Marketplace layout. Your business name or your last name, first initial will be listed with space allocated to you. Confirmation letters and parking permits will be sent to you by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

**SETUP AND DEPARTURE HOURS:** The Marketplace is open from 10 AM through 6 PM Saturday and Sunday. Set up is between 8 AM and 10 AM. Volunteers may be available to help unload and reload at the beginning and ending of each day. If you plan on setting up before 8 AM, no help will be available. Departure time is 7 PM Saturday and 8 PM on Sunday. **WE EXPECT ALL VENDORS TO REMAIN OPEN UNTIL 6 PM EACH DAY.** The Marketplace area must be vacated by 8 PM Sunday. There are **NO RAIN DATES AND NO REFUNDS!** Also, there is no electricity or water available for your booth.

**JURIED SHOW:** Frontier Days, Inc. or the Marketplace Committee has the right to select vendors, to close booths and ban sales or displays of wares and services. Sales of **ANY TYPE** of WEAPONS, AMMUNITIONS, FIREWORKS, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, as well as used clothing, food and/or beverage is **ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED**

**SPACES:** Spaces are 10 X 10 feet each so that they will accommodate canopies or pop-up tents.

**LAYOUT:** We try to group crafters with crafters and vendors with vendors. We will continue to use small clusters of booths in an attempt to increase customer traffic flow. A crafter is defined as a person selling art or craft items that have been hand crafted. A vendor is defined as a person selling previously purchased items. Frontier Days, Inc. will **NOT** accept any business vendors having a corporate affiliation, i.e. Mary Kay, Discovery Toys, World Book Encyclopedias, etc.

**SECURITY:** A security guard will be on duty overnight Saturday in the Marketplace area. We discourage leaving your merchandise overnight. If you choose to leave items, you will do so at your own risk and a signed release waiver is required.

**AMENITIES:** We provide nearby toilet facilities, refuse cans. A variety of food and beverage items are available for purchase a short distance away.
