Festival Organization

The Arlington Heights Festival Committee is made of volunteers just like you. Here is how the volunteers are organized: Board of Directors, Festival Co-Chairmen, Area Coordinators, Event Chairmen, and Red Shirt Volunteers

Board of Directors

There are nine members of the Board of Directors who oversee the policies and procedures of the organization. They are elected by the general membership and serve a two year term.

Festival Co-Chairmen

The two Co-Chairmen oversee the operational side of the Frontier Days' Fourth of July festival. They are appointed by the Board.

Area Coordinator Role

A Coordinator is responsible for obtaining chairmen for all events in their area. They assist their event chairmen with the budgeting and planning for their specific event or operation. An Area Coordinator also attends monthly meetings with the Festival Co-Chairmen and other Co-Coordinators for overall communication and planning of the Festival.

Chairman Role

A chairman, with the assistance of the Area Coordinator, plans the event, obtains volunteers for shift(s) during the event, obtains equipment and supplies, and meets budget allowances.
